

**Heb 6:1 AKJV/PCE** Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,

**Heb 6:2 AKJV/PCE** Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

**Heb 6:3 AKJV/PCE** And this will we do, if God permit.

**Heb 6:4 AKJV/PCE** For *it is* impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,

**Heb 6:5 AKJV/PCE** And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

**Heb 6:6 AKJV/PCE** If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.

**Heb 6:7 AKJV/PCE** For the earth which drinketh in the rain that cometh oft upon it, and bringeth forth herbs meet for them by whom it is dressed, receiveth blessing from God:

**Heb 6:8 AKJV/PCE** But that which beareth thorns and briers *is* rejected, and *is* nigh unto cursing; whose end *is* to be burned.

**Heb 6:9 AKJV/PCE** But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.

**Heb 6:10 AKJV/PCE** For God *is* not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

**Heb 6:11 AKJV/PCE** And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

**Heb 6:12 AKJV/PCE** That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

**Heb 6:13 AKJV/PCE** For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he swore by himself,

**Heb 6:14 AKJV/PCE** Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

**Heb 6:15 AKJV/PCE** And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

**Heb 6:16 AKJV/PCE** For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation *is* to them an end of all strife.

**Heb 6:17 AKJV/PCE** Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath:

**Heb 6:18 AKJV/PCE** That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

**Heb 6:19 AKJV/PCE** Which *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

**Heb 6:20 AKJV/PCE** Whither the forerunner is for us entered, *even* Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.
